

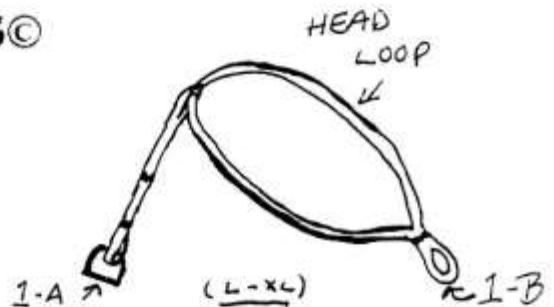

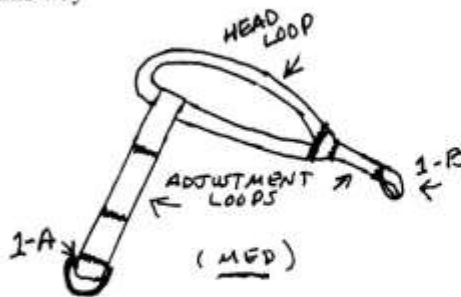

KAYLOR COLLAR BODY HARNESS©

- 1) Place your bird on your lap and begin to stroke and love on your bird from beak to back. When the bird begins to melt, reach over and grab the head loop with one hand while continuing to stroke with the other hand. Slip the head loop over the bird's head on the same stroke as affection stroke. (We have found this way to be less stressful and more loving for you and your bird.) D-ring(1a) will be at the chest. Body strap loop (1b) will be on the back between the wings. Smooth side of harness should be next to your bird's body.



- 2) Put body strap through the loop at the back in between the wings. Some adjustments of the harness may be needed to fit your bird better. Adjustment loops are between stitches. (You'll notice that the body strap is probably way bigger than your bird, after fitting, please cut off excess strap searing end with a match.)(please make sure it is off your bird before striking match)



- 3) Slip strap underneath wings and attach at D-ring loop leaving a finger sized gap between the bird and the body strap. **Please note:** Wing feathers should not be under the body strap.
- 4) Attach leash to D-ring with the clip. **Caution:** If your bird is a "Destroyer", you may find it necessary to cut the clip off and tie the leash to your bird's harness.

You and your friend are now ready to enjoy playing outside. Caution: Do not leave harnessed birds unattended.

We do guarantee the size and quality of the harness. If the head loop size is wrong, just let us know and another head loop will be sent asap ,at no charge .

You might ask yourself," What if my bird doesn't like the harness?" Not all birds are going to take to this right away. Again, only you know your bird. If you can scratch, tickle and touch under your bird's wings, and bac, you've got a good start. DON'T FIGHT THE BIRD YOU WILL LOSE. The last thing you need is a mad bird. Neither of you need the stress. Put the harness away for another day. Take your time. Keep in mind that this is completely foreign and your bird doesn't realize yet that this is for fun and enjoyment. It must be put on in a loving and no stress method.

If your bird is chewing on the harness, it's probably because he or she is not having fun. Sometimes distraction is the key. Give your bird a piece of fruit, nut or it's favorite hand toy to play with. We have thousands of birds now enjoying camping, boating, hiking, bicycles (our macaws love it) or just a nice walk outside. Remember, be patient and enjoy.
